



Walter Sharp, Jr. Memorial 2017 Scholarship Application

The mission of the Photographic Arts Society is to provide a network of fellowship for individuals, amateur and professional, interested in enhancing and expanding their photographic skills as well as those who appreciate photography as an artistic expression.

In order to promote our mission, the Photographic Arts Society will award a \$750.00 scholarship to one student of photography whose application and submissions exceeds in all the required areas. This scholarship honors the memory of photographer and longtime Photographic Arts Society Member Walter Sharp, Jr.

The criteria for submissions are as follows:

- Current enrollment or accepted as a student of photography at a community college, college or university. College students must provide a copy of class schedule or contact information for photography instructor/faculty member. High School students must submit proof of enrollment in a college or university photography program.
- Submit a written or typed comprehensive statement in hard copy of your photography goals and how the scholarship award will be used to help achieve these goals.
- Submit a selection of no less than eight (8) images black and white or color. Submissions may be 8x10 mounted photographs, slides or on a CD or DVD.
- Name and telephone number must be on the back of each photograph, slide or disk.

Submission deadline is Wednesday June 1, 2017. The Scholarship Committee will not consider applications postmarked after this date. The award ceremony and reception will be held on the evening of *July 20, 2017 at 7pm. The recipient must be prepared to give a presentation of their work at reception.
